WHEREAS, The Fire Commissioners of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 5, (Napavine) are the authorized governing body for the District, and;

WHEREAS, The District provides emergency medical services for the protection of life, health, and welfare of the residents.

WHEREAS, the Fire Commissioners have the statutory right to ask the voters of the District to authorize the collection of property tax in order to provide for and maintain effective Emergency Medical Services within the District, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners have determined that the District may experience financial difficulty in the near future, due to increasing cost of maintaining current EMS services, which may detrimentally effect the provision of emergency medical services within the District.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, That the Board of Fire Commissioners of Lewis County Fire District No. 5, request that the following issue be placed before the voters on the August 2017 election ballot.


EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES




