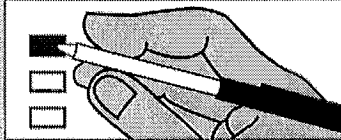

Instructions

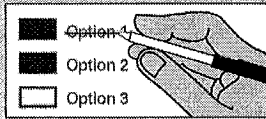
How to vote
