

Morton School Dist No. 214 Bonds to Expand, Renovate and Construct School Facilities

Proposition No. 1

The Board of Directors of Morton School District No. 214 adopted Resolution No. 16/17-05 concerning a proposition to improve infrastructure, safety and educational opportunities. This proposition would authorize the District to: expand and renovate Morton Junior-Senior High School (including constructing additional classrooms to relocate the elementary students, replacing the high school gymnasium roof and upgrading windows, mechanical and plumbing systems); construct a new bus garage; construct a new football/track stadium; issue no more than \$10,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 23 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 16/17-05.
