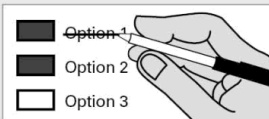

Replacement of Expiring EMS Levy

The Board of the Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 17 adopted Resolution No. 42314 providing for the replacement of the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) levy that expires in 2014. In place of the levy expiring in 2014, shall the Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 17 be authorized to impose a regular property tax levy of fifty (50) cents per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for each of six consecutive years to maintain emergency medical services with collection beginning in 2015?

Levy of Property Tax for Maintenance and Operations

The Governing Board of Riverside Fire Authority adopted Resolution No. 14-01 concerning a proposition to support adequate fire protection and rescue services, facilities, maintenance, staffing and operations by authorizing RFA to levy excess taxes in the amount of \$800,000.00 in 2014 to be collected in 2015 at an approximate levy rate of \$0.49 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation (the actual rate will be based on assessed values).
