Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted. If the original ballot is destroyed, spoiled or lost, a replacement ballot may be obtained by calling (360) 740-1278 or toll free within Lewis County (800) 562-6130 ext 1278. Follow instructions on the secrecy and lavender envelopes to return ballot. Mail or deposit it in the drop box located outside the Auditor's office at 351 NW North St, Chehalis, from 8 AM to 5 PM Monday-Friday and on Election Day from 7 AM to 8 PM. Accessible voting units will be available 20 days prior to Election Day. If you have changed your permanent residence address, call this office to ensure the ballot you receive in future elections contains the races and issues for your residential address. If you have any questions about your eligibility to vote in this election, please contact this office.


