

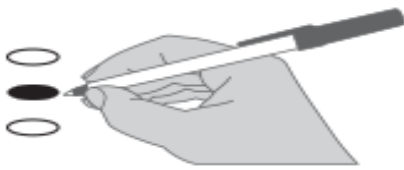

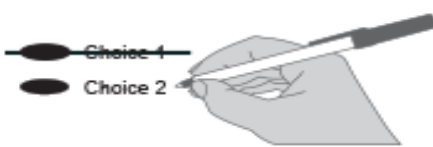
**How to vote**



Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice.

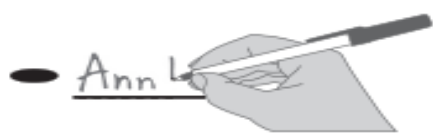
Vote for one candidate on the ballot. A ballot with votes for more than one candidate **will not** count.
