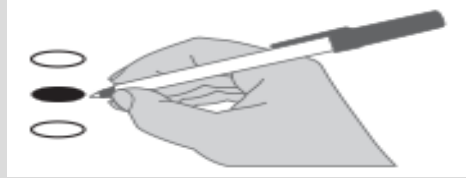

**How to vote**

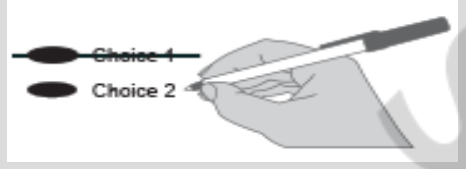


Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice.

**LEVY LID LIFT FOR SUPPORT OF FIRE SERVICES**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 1 (Onalaska Fire Department) adopted Resolution No. 2020-06, concerning an increase in fire services funding.

This proposition would provide funds for the continued operation and maintenance of fire services, equipment and facilities. It authorizes a maximum regular property tax rate for collection in 2022 of \$1.35 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. The 2022 levy amount will be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for subsequent levies under chapter 84.55 RCW. Qualifying low-income seniors, disabled veterans and other people with disabilities will be exempt from the levy increase under RCW 84.36.381.

**TEMPORARY SINGLE YEAR LEVY LID LIFT**

The Board of Commissioners of Lewis County Fire Protection District 13 proposes a single-year temporary lid lift. If passed, Proposition 1 would permit the district to increase the current levy rate to \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation in the first year beginning collection in 2022, and to increase the rate for up to an additional four years using an annual limit factor not to exceed 1% per year.

**TAX LEVY FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of the Riverside Regional Fire Authority has passed Resolution No. 20-15 to authorize the subsequent approval of the existing EMS tax levy. If passed, Proposition No. 1 would permit the Authority to levy for collection in 2022, and for five years thereafter, an emergency medical services property tax levy at a rate not to exceed \$0.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of taxable property within the Authority, which is the same rate authorized for collection in 2021.
