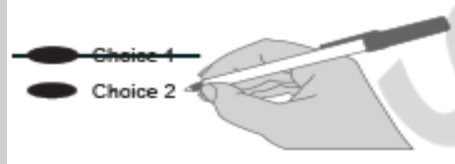
**How to vote**

**TAX LEVY FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE OR SERVICES**

On April 12th, 2021 the City of Chehalis, Washington, adopted Resolution No. 5-2021 concerning a proposition to replace an expiring levy. This Proposition would authorize a levy for Emergency Medical Services (EMS) of up to Fifty Cents (\$0.50) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed value of property with collection beginning in the year 2022 and continuing through the next five (5) years (2023 through 2027).

**Proposition 1  
Fire Protection District No. 1 - Onalaska  
Levy Lid Lift for Support of Fire Services**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 1 (Onalaska Fire Department) adopted Resolution No. 2021-03, concerning an increase in fire services funding. This Proposition would provide funds for the continued operation and maintenance of fire services, equipment and facilities. It authorizes a maximum regular property tax rate for collection in 2022 of \$1.35 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. The 2022 levy amount will be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for subsequent levies under chapter 84.55 RCW. Qualifying low-income seniors, disabled veterans and other people with disabilities will be exempt from the levy increase under RCW 84.36.381.

**REPLACEMENT OF EXPIRING EMS LEVY**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Lewis County Fire Protection District 2 has adopted Resolutions 2021-05 providing for replacement of an Emergency Medical Services Levy.

In Place of a levy expiring in 2021, shall the Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 2 (Toledo Fire Department) be authorized to continue a regular property tax levy up to \$.50 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for each of six consecutive years, collection beginning in 2022, for providing Emergency Medical Services?

**MULTIPLE YEAR LEVY LID LIFT**

Lewis County Fire District No. 5 Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2021-04 to restore the District's regular property tax levy. Levy approval would increase the regular property tax levy to \$1.28/\$1,000 assessed valuation for 2022 and set the limit factor increase for 2023 through 2027 at 106%. The levy would be used to provide fire protection and emergency medical services. The 2027 levy amount will be used to calculate subsequent levies under 84.55 RCW.

LEWIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 15 - WINLOCK**

**PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**

The Board of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 15 adopted Resolution No. 2021-04 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

This proposition authorizes the District to establish its regular property tax levy at \$1.28 per \$1,000 of assessed value to be assessed in 2021 and collected in 2022. The funds will maintain and improve fire protection, emergency medical services and facilities, replace apparatus and equipment, and provide for firefighter safety. The maximum allowable levy in 2021 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
