How to vote



Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice. **Do not use felt tip markers.**

Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

If you make a mistake



Draw a line through the entire measure response or candidate's name. Then you may make another choice.

Optional Write-in



To vote for a candidate not listed for that race, fill in the oval to the left of the line and print the name of the candidate.

**Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 3
Proposition No. 1
Property Tax Levy for Fire Protection and Emergency
Medical Services**

The Board of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 3 adopted Resolution No. 23-02 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

This proposition would authorize the District to establish its 2023 property tax levy at \$.90 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation with annual adjustments for the five succeeding years based on the greater of four percent or the 12-month West Region CPI-U reported in June of each levy year but not to exceed eight percent, subject to statutory limits. The maximum allowable levy in the final year shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations.

Proposition No. 1
Property Tax Levy for Fire Protection and Emergency
Medical Services**

The Board of Lewis County Fire District No. 5 adopted Resolution No. 2023-04 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District Operations.

This proposition authorizes the District to establish its regular property tax levy permanently at \$1.20 per \$1000.00 of assessed value to be assessed in 2023 and collected in 2024. The funds will maintain and improve fire protection, emergency medical services and facilities, replace apparatus and equipment, and provide for resident staffing of Station 2 on Jackson Highway. The maximum allowable levy in 2023 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.

The funds will maintain and improve fire protection, emergency medical services and provide for 24-hour paid staffing of personnel and necessary equipment. The maximum allowable levy in 2023 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
