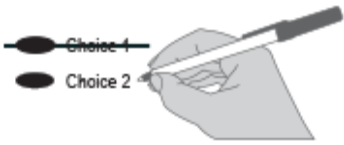

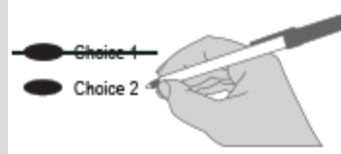

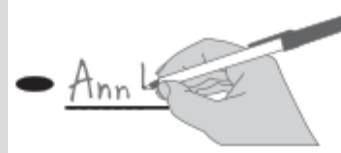

**Proposition No. 1
Napavine School District No. 14
Bonds to Improve Safety and Expand and Renovate Junior/Senior High Facilities**

The Board of Directors of Napavine School District No. 14 adopted Resolution No. 22-23-19, concerning bonds to improve safety, relieve overcrowding, and enhance learning environment. This proposition would authorize the District to: expand and renovate Junior/Senior High Facilities (including making health, safety, accessibility and infrastructure improvements; constructing secured controlled entry and kitchen; expanding cafeteria/commons; constructing a new, permanent classroom building for middle school students; constructing a new middle school auxiliary gymnasium); issue no more than \$19,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 25 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 22-23-19.

Proposition No. 1
Property Tax Levy for Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services**

The Board of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 3 adopted Resolution No. 23-04 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

This proposition would authorize the District to establish its 2023 property tax levy at \$.90 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation with annual adjustments for the five succeeding years based on the greater of four percent or the 12-month West Region CPI-U reported in June of each levy year but not to exceed eight percent, subject to statutory limits. The maximum allowable levy in the final year shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations.

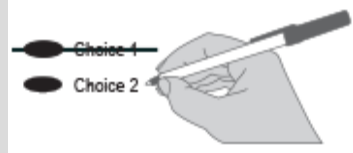

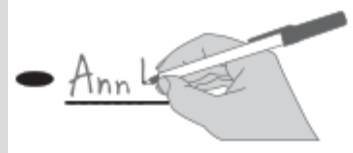
