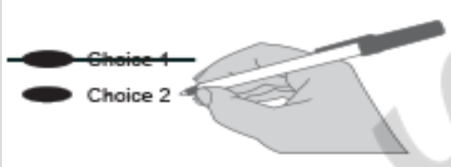

School Programs and Operations Replacement Levy

The Board of Directors of White Pass School District No. 303 adopted Resolution No. 8-25, concerning a proposition for a replacement levy for education. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, replacing an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of school programs and operations expenses not funded by the State, including teachers, support staff, technology, curriculum, athletics, and facility maintenance and operations:

Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 4  
Proposition No. 1  
Bonds to Construct a New Fire Station

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 4 adopted Resolution No. 25-03, concerning emergency response facilities to protect public health, life and property. This proposition would authorize the District to: construct a new fire station to replace the existing station, sized to meet current and future firefighting and emergency response needs; issue no more than \$3,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 15 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 25-03.
