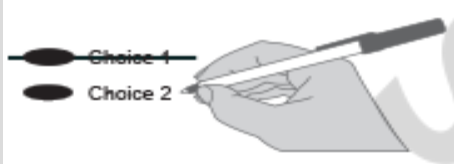
How to vote

Centralia Transportation Benefit District

Sales and Use Tax Levy for Transportation Needs

The City of Centralia, acting as the Centralia Transportation Benefit District, adopted Resolution No. 2826 concerning a sales and use tax for transportation projects. This proposition would renew the current sales and use tax of two-tenths of one percent (0.2%) for an additional term of ten years, beginning January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2035, to fund transportation improvements, traffic engineering and control, and the general operation, maintenance, and repair of city streets, bridges, and other transportation infrastructure.

Replacement Educational Programs & Operations Levy

The Board of Directors of Adna School District No. 226 adopted Resolution No. 24-25-16, concerning a proposition supporting educational programs not funded by the state. This proposition would authorize the District to replace an expiring levy by levying the following excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District, to fund educational programs and operations, including: course/program options; class size reduction; classroom technology; STEM education; facilities maintenance; extracurricular activities, including athletics and robotics; and a school nurse:

Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 3
Levy Lid Lift

The Board of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 3 adopted Resolution No. 25-03 concerning a proposition to establish its regular property tax levy.

This proposition authorizes the District to establish its regular property tax levy at \$.90 per \$1,000 of assessed value to be assessed in 2025 and collected in 2026. The funds will maintain and improve fire protection, and emergency medical services, replace apparatus and equipment, and provide for firefighter safety. The dollar amount of the 2025 levy collected in 2026 shall serve as the base for computing subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
