### Instructions

#### How to vote



Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice. **Do not use felt tip markers.**

Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

#### If you make a mistake



Draw a line through the entire measure response or candidate's name. Then you may make another choice.

#### Optional Write-in

To vote for a candidate not listed for that race, fill in the oval to the left of the line and print the name of the candidate

**Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 3 Proposition No. 1**  
**Restore EMS Property Tax Levy**  
The Board of Lewis County Fire District #3 (Mossyrock & surrounding areas) adopted Resolution No. 26-04 concerning restoration of its Emergency Medical Services regular property tax levy.  
This proposition would authorize the District to restore its regular EMS property tax levy to \$0.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value to be assessed in 2026 and collected in 2027. The funds will maintain and improve emergency medical services. The maximum allowable levy in 2026 shall serve as the base for computing subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.

**Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 8 Proposition No. 1**  
**Property Tax Levy for Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services**  
The Board of Lewis County Fire Protection District No. 8 adopted Resolution No. 2026-01 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.  
This proposition would fund fire protection and emergency medical services by restoring the District's existing regular property tax levy in 2026 to \$.88 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation and authorize annual adjustments for the nine succeeding years based on the greater of one percent or the 12-month West Region CPI-U reported in June of each levy year. The maximum allowable levy in 2035 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations.
