Voting Instructions

In each race, you may vote for any one choice listed.
- Put your ballot in the ballot secrecy envelope.
- Place the ballot secrecy envelope inside the return envelope and seal.

Sign:

- Sign & date the voter declaration

- Return your ballot by mail or ballot drop box

By Drop Box:

No postage needed.

Ballot drop boxes will be open at least 18 days before election day; close at 8:00 pm on November 3.

By Mail:

No stamp needed.

Ballots must be postmarked by November 3rd.

USPS recommends mailing by October 27th.
